

HPO Sponsored Events and Fundraisers

Fall Fundraiser: Mr. Z's is the first fundraiser of the school year. The catalog offers wrapping paper, ornaments, jewelry, calendars, and other cute items for purchase. The goal is to reach sales of \$70 per child; if you choose not to participate a monetary donation of \$35 per student is appreciated.

Family Movie Night: Students and families will get to chat, have some snacks and watch a family oriented (PG or G-rated) movie together with friends in the gym! Students are welcome to wear their PJ's, bring blankets, pillows and huggies!

Fall/Spring Book Fair: This is a way for the HPO to raise funds for our library. The book fair is sponsored by Scholastic Books in the library and is staffed by parent volunteers during conference week. The kids can preview the books and bring home a wish list. Payments are accepted through your child for purchase or you can stop in yourself and do some shopping on your own.

Fall Festival: A family event with chili dogs, pumpkin decorating, balloons, animals and games. There is a raffle of "Themed Baskets" that are put together by each grade from donations received by their families! These are always a hit and the Festival is loaded with family fun!

Art To Remember: This is a fundraising event that is now sponsored by HPO to help our Art room earn extra money. The children make a piece of work that is transferred onto any item you wish. Take a look and you may find some great gifts to give to family & friends from your child!

Holiday Gift Shop, Breakfast & Photos with Santa: This is an opportunity for the students to purchase gifts for their family members and/or friends. The student's enjoy shopping on their own for the holiday season. On Saturday morning, there will be a Holiday Shop & Breakfast, as well as an opportunity to have your photo taken with Santa!

Adult Crazy Bowl! This is an Adult only event at Arnold Bowl for a night of socializing and crazy bowling! It is a great way to meet other parents and is always a good time for all!

Pizza Bingo: The name says it all. A family event with pizza slices available for purchase, as well as soda, popcorn and candy. Play BINGO and win prizes. Dining Out Night: This is a new event to Hagemann. It will be similar to McDonald's night. Enjoy a night out to dinner at restaurants such as Culvers or Steak N Shake. A percentage of the sales will go to HPO. More information will follow closer to the event.

Spring Fundraiser: This fundraiser will be an event that gets our kids active and raise money for HPO. Last year's event was Hop for Hagemann and was a big success. Information regarding this event will be sent out in the spring.

School Picnic: A Family event at Hagemann Elementary with games, rides, BBQ and fun for all. Volunteers are needed to help set up, staff the booths in the gym and take down. This is an event not to be missed!

Staff Appreciation: This is a celebration to show appreciation to the Hagemann Staff. It is set in a fun theme including invitations, games and a catered lunch. It is a blast for all who are involved and the staff looks forward to it every year!

Grocery Store Certificates: You can purchase grocery store certificates through Hagemann for Dierbergs and Shop n' Save. 5% of your certificate purchase goes back to our school. A script card can also be picked up at Schnucks and percentage of what you buy at Schnucks will given to HPO.

Wednesday Envelopes: Wednesday envelopes are the main line of communication for the school and HPO to the Hagemann families. Each Wednesday, a group of volunteers stuff the "Wednesday envelopes" with information about things going on at school. If you have more than one child at Hagemann the envelope will go home with the youngest child ONLY. In addition, this year we will be making an attempt to take as much as we can online. Each family will be given the option to "Opt In" to stay with paper envelopes. Forms will be sent home in September.

Buzz Books: HPO provides each family with a buzz book at the beginning of the school year. You will quickly find out how important it is to have this at your fingertips at all times. Extra copies can be purchased for a minimal cost.

Gift Cards: HPO offers gift cards for a variety of stores and restaurants. A portion of the proceeds from the sale of these benefit our school. If you are interested in purchasing these, order forms are available through HPO.

Mother (Special Person)/Son Dance and Father (Special Person)/ Daughter Dance: A brand new event to HPO. This event is meant to be a special event for your daughter or son. Music, snacks and fun with friends from school.
